EXPLANATION:

The National City Fire Department (NCFD), in coordination with AP Triton Consulting, conducted a comprehensive Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Transportation & Optimization Study, which was presented to the City Council on November 18, 2025. Per Resolution 2025 – 166, attached as “Exhibit A,” the City Council accepted the Study and authorized the City Manager to evaluate the costs associated with the study’s recommendations. As part of the development phase, the NCFD would like to present its progress toward building a Public Provider Ground Emergency Medical Transport Program as a permanent emergency service delivery model for the National City Fire Department.
