


# **Public Hearing**

Conditional Use Permit for on-site distilled spirits and live entertainment at an existing beer and wine bar (Machete Beer House) located at 2325 Highland Ave. 2022-08 CUP

# **Overhead**




#### Site Characteristics:

- Subject property is 0.19 acres developed with a 2,800 sq. ft. commercial building
  - ➤ Machete Beer House occupies approximately half of the building in a 1,400 sq. ft. suite
  - ➤ Bar currently holds ABC Type 42 license
  - ➤ El Cubilete Tires occupies other half of building/property
  - > Four parking spaces existing for the bar
- Area is mostly commercial in nature with single-family properties to the east across the alley

### **Proposed Use:**

- Type 48 license (On-Sale General Public Premises) upgrade from Type 42 to allow distilled spirits
- Current business hours are 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. daily.
  - > Only a coffee window operates until 2:00 p.m.
  - ➤ No change requested
- Applicant is also proposing to offer live entertainment in the form of jazz, mariachi, and DJs. All live entertainment will be indoors.
- The bar has an occupancy of 49 persons, inclusive of employees, patrons, and performers.

### **Analysis:**

- Request consistent with Code requirements (alcohol):
  - ➤ Mailing 660 feet owners/occupants (654)
  - ➤ Community Meeting held on March 5, 2022 with one attendee
  - ➤ Distance from schools property has been in use as a bar prior to the requirements of the code

#### Council Policy 707

- > Requires condition related to sale of food for on-sale alcohol
- Policy does not anticipate a CUP for a bar or similar establishment
- ➤ Machete Beer House precedes requirements of Policy 707

### **Analysis:**

- Current hours of operation are proposed to remain:
  - > 6:00 am to 2:00 am
  - Proposed for live entertainment as well
- Census tract 116.01
  - > 3 on-sale licenses (less than recommended by ABC)
  - ➤ No addition of license (existing)
- PD Risk Assessment
  - > 18 points (medium risk)
  - > Updated attachment in staff report

- First CUP in National City for a Type 48 license
- Machete Beer House currently sells until 2:00 am
  - > Business operates a coffee window until 2:00 pm most days
- Another business, Aja Lounge, also sells until 2:00 am under a Type 48 license without a CUP

- Proposed hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. daily far exceed recent CUP approvals
- Poses potential noise issues for nearby residential use
- Staff suggests reduced hours, both in duration and days.

- 2022-18 CUP (pending City Council approval)
- Recommended 1:00 am for alcohol sales
- > Recommended live entertainment inside:
  - > 12:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Sunday to Thursday
  - > 12:00 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. Friday and Saturday
  - ➤ Modified hours for adjacent school (outside only)

- Hours of operation (live entertainment)
- Options: Starting later, reducing evening hours, modifying hours related to nearby school, etc.:
- Live entertainment:
  - > 12:00 pm to 10:00 pm Sunday
  - > 2:00 pm to 10:00 pm Monday through Thursday\*
  - > 2:00 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. Friday\*
  - > 12:00 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. Saturday
  - > \*From 4:00 pm while Olivewood Elementary is in session
- Generally, after the coffee window concludes operation
- Building occupancy (49)

#### **Comments:**

- No comment received from Institute for Public Strategies (IPS)
- Usually recommend Responsible Beverage Sales and Service (RBSS), which is included as a standard condition of approval.

#### **Public Comment:**

- No comments provided at the time the staff report was written
- One public comment received in opposition to the addition of live entertainment
  - Concerns over noise and other complaints such as loitering and litter

#### **Conditions:**

- > Recommended conditions reflect applicant's request
  - > Hours of operation for alcohol sales
  - ➤ Hours of operation for live entertainment (indoors)
- Standard City Council Policy 707 conditions apply
  - > Exceptions for requirements related to the sale of food
- No off-site sales
- Live entertainment incidental to bar use (no advertised events)
- Occupancy

# Conditions (cont.):

- Compliance with Title 12 (Noise) of the NCMC
- Windows and doors to remain closed after 9:00 pm
- Only tables for coffee window permitted outdoors (no alcohol consumption)

# **Summary:**

- Proposed use consistent with General Plan
  - ➤ Alcohol sales for on-site consumption and live entertainment both conditionally-allowed in the MXC-2 zone
- Addition of live entertainment accessory to the bar
- Inclusion of conditions requiring compliance with noise standards and operating hours intended to alleviate concerns related to area impacts
- Notice of Exemption of CEQA

### **Options:**

- ➤ Approve CUP based on attached findings / findings determined by the Commission; or
- ➤ Deny CUP based on attached findings / findings determined by the Commission; or
- > Continue the item for additional information
- Staff recommending approval with appropriate conditions
- ➤ Notice of Decision to City Council
