WHEREAS, the Camacho Recreation Center HVAC Replacement Project, CIP NO.20-07 ("Project"), will remove the existing HVAC system and install a new HVAC system on the roof of the Camacho Recreation Center located at 1810 East 22nd St, National City, CA 91950; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2021, the City posted the bid solicitation on PlanetBids, a free public electronic bidding system for contractors, and on July 26, 2021, and July 28, 2021, the City advertised in local newspapers; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2021, the City received two (2) bids by the 1:00 p.m. deadline; and

WHEREAS, SWCS, Inc. was the apparent lowest bidder with a total bid amount of \$230,704.00; and

WHEREAS, upon review of all documents submitted, City staff determined SWCS, Inc. the lowest responsive bidder qualified to perform the work as described in the Project specifications; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends awarding a contract to SWCS, Inc. in the not-to-exceed amount of \$230,704.00; and

WHEREAS, City staff requests City Council authorize the Mayor to execute the contract with SWCS, Inc. for the Project; and

WHEREAS, City staff further recommends authorizing a 15% contingency amount up to \$34,605.60 for any unforeseen conditions that may arise during the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Awards the Camacho Recreation Center HVAC Replacement Project, CIP No. 20-07, to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, to wit:

SWCS, INC.


Section 2: Authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract for \$230,704.00 with SWCS, Inc. for the Camacho Recreation Center HVAC Replacement Project, CIP No. 20-07.

Section 3: Authorizes a 15% contingency in the amount of up to \$34,605.60 for any unforeseen changes.

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Section 4: The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.



**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY,
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO PORTILLO CONCRETE, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$4,060,691 FOR THE EUCLID AVENUE BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN
ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT, CIP NO. 18-10, AUTHORIZE A 10% CONTINGENCY
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$406,069.10 FOR ANY UNFORESEEN CHANGES, AND
AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT**

WHEREAS, the Euclid Avenue Bicycle and Pedestrian Enhancements Project will construct nearly two miles of traffic calming, bicycle and pedestrian enhancements on Euclid Avenue from the northern City limits at Cervantes Avenue south to East 24th Street; and

WHEREAS, project improvements will include traffic calming through road diets, curb extensions, median refuge islands, Class II buffered bicycle lanes, Class III bicycle routes, Class IV bikeways with bend-outs, high visibility crosswalks, pedestrian actuated LED-enhanced crosswalk signs, two High-Intensity Activated crosswalks (HAWKs) located near Paradise Valley Hospital, and a new traffic signal at the entrance to Euclid Plaza (Vallarta Supermarket) and Windsor Heights Apartments; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2019, per Resolution No. 2019- 19, the City Council executed PSA No. S18 with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for the Euclid Avenue Bicycle and Pedestrian Enhancements Project to allow for reimbursement of up to \$3,335,000 in eligible project expenditures through the State Active Transportation Program; and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2019, the Engineering Department publicly opened, examined, and declared three (3) sealed bids for the Euclid Avenue Bicycle and Pedestrian Enhancements Project; and

WHEREAS, Portillo Concrete, Inc., was the lowest responsive bidder qualified to perform the work as described in the project specifications with a total bid amount of \$4,060,691; and


WHEREAS, a 10% contingency amount up to \$406,069.10 for any unforeseen conditions that may arise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of National City hereby awards the contract for the Euclid Avenue Bicycle and Pedestrian Enhancements Project to Portillo Concrete, Inc.



**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY,
1) AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DICK MILLER, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$2,330,869.70 FOR THE PARADISE CREEK PARK EXPANSION PROJECT, CIP NO.
18-16; 2) AUTHORIZING A 15% CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$349,630.45
FOR ANY UNFORESEEN CHANGES; AND 3) AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
EXECUTE THE CONTRACT**

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2017, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2017-73 authorizing the filing of an application for the Urban Greening Grant Program funds through the California Department of Natural Resources for National City's Paradise Creek Park Project and authorizing the City Manager to execute the grant agreement with California Department of Natural Resources, if selected for grant award; and

WHEREAS, in November 2017, staff was notified that National City had been awarded a \$1,151,265 Urban Greening Grant for the project which the City Manager subsequently executed in July 2018; and

WHEREAS, in October 16, 2018, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2018-182 awarding a contract for the construction of the Paradise Creek Park Site Remediation and Improvements Project that will provide the site remediation, grading, and infrastructure improvements necessary to construct the new approximately 4-acre Paradise Creek Park; and

WHEREAS, the Paradise Creek Park Expansion Project will develop an approximately 4-acre Community Park with decomposed granite (DG) walking paths, educational and interpretive signage, trees, native vegetation, bioretention areas for storm water treatment, community garden, playground and passive recreational areas, and other amenities on the west side of Paradise Creek between W. 22nd Street and W. 19th Street; and

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2019, the bid solicitation was posted on PlanetBids, a free public electronic bidding system for contractors and on July 2, 2019 and July 9, 2019, the bid solicitation was advertised in local newspapers; and

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2019, six (6) bids were received electronically on PlanetBids by the 2:00 p.m. deadline with Dick Miller Inc. being the apparent lowest bidder with a total bid amount of \$2,330,869.70; and

WHEREAS, upon review of all documents submitted, Dick Miller, Inc.'s bid was deemed responsive and lowest responsible bidder qualified to perform the work as described in the project specification with an estimated completion date of May 2020; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding a contract to Dick Miller, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of \$2,330,869.70 and to authorize a 15% contingency in the amount of \$349,630.45 to address any unforeseen conditions that may arise.



RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, 1) AWARDED A CONTRACT TO EAGLE PAVING COMPANY, INC. IN THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$1,086,911.00 FOR THE SWEETWATER ROAD SAFETY ENHANCEMENT PROJECT, CIP NO. 19-12; 2) AUTHORIZING A 15% CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$163,036.65 FOR ANY UNFORESEEN CHANGES; AND 3) AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Sweetwater Road Safety Enhancement Project, CIP No. 19-12 (Project) will provide a 2" grind and overlay on 0.5 miles of Sweetwater Road from Stockman Street to the east side of Via Romaya Street within the existing right-of way, upgrade ADA ramps to the current standard within the Project limits, as well as address damaged cross gutter, curb and gutter and will also install new street lighting, raised median for traffic calming, new striping including crosswalk and class II bike lane along Sweetwater Road; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2016, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) awarded the City of National City (City) a \$680,940 Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2020, Caltrans authorized the City to proceed with the construction phase in the amount of \$680,940 (\$604,440 for construction and \$76,500 for construction management) with a local match of \$83,475 local match; and

WHEREAS, the bid solicitation was posted on PlanetBids, a free public electronic bidding system for contractors and on December 10, 2020, and was advertised in local newspapers on December 21, 2020 and December 28, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2021, six (6) bids were received by the 11:00 a.m. deadline for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Eagle Paving Company, Inc., was the lowest responsive bidder qualified to perform the work as described in the project specifications with a total bid amount of \$1,086,911.00; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends awarding a contract to Eagle Paving Company, Inc., in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1,086,911.00; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends authorizing a 15% contingency amount up to \$163,036.65 for any unforeseen conditions that may arise during the Project.



RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, 1) AWARDING A CONTRACT TO BLUE PACIFIC ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$957,028.89 FOR THE SWEETWATER RIVER BIKEWAY CONNECTIONS/30TH STREET BICYCLE FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, CIP NO. 18-14; 2) AUTHORIZING A 15% CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$143,554.33 FOR ANY UNFORESEEN CHANGES; 3) AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT; AND 4) AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENGINEERING GRANTS FUND APPROPRIATION OF \$889,000 AND CORRESPONDING REVENUE BUDGET

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2015, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) awarded the City of National City (City) a \$1,129,000 Active Transportation Program (ATP) grant for the Sweetwater River Bikeway Connections Project (Project) and at their meeting on December 7, 2016, the California Transportation Commission (CTC) allocated \$25,000 for the Project Approval/Environmental Document (PAED) phase; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2017, per City Council Resolution No. 2017-19, City Council executed Program Supplement Agreement No. P036 with Caltrans for the Project to allow for reimbursement of eligible project expenditures through the State ATP; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2017, the CTC allocated \$165,000 for the Preliminary Engineering (PS&E) phase, which included preparation of construction plans, specifications and estimates; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2017, per City Council Resolution No. 2017-195, City Council authorized the establishment of an Engineering Grants Fund appropriation in the amount of \$165,000 and a corresponding revenue budget to allow staff to proceed with preliminary engineering for the Project, which will be reimbursed by the State ATP grant; and

WHEREAS, the Sweetwater River Bikeway Connections/30th Street Bicycle Facilities Improvements Project includes traffic calming and pedestrian and bicycle enhancements on 30th Street between "D" Avenue and N. 2nd Avenue, connecting existing pedestrian and bicycle facilities near Sweetwater High School to the regional Sweetwater River Bike Path off N. 2nd Avenue; and

WHEREAS, improvements will include street resurfacing, ADA upgrades, approximately 1 mile of Class II bike lanes with signage, traffic signal modifications at Highland Avenue and East 30th Street, concrete pads at bus stops, and gateway enhancements at both entrances to the Sweetwater River Bike Path located at W. 33rd Street and N. 2nd Avenue; and

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2019, the bid solicitation was posted on PlanetBids, a free public electronic bidding system for contractors and on August 15, 2019 and August 20, 2019, the bid solicitation was advertised in local newspapers; and

WHEREAS, on September 3, 2019, six (6) bids were received by the 11:00 a.m. deadline with Blue Pacific Engineering & Construction being the apparent lowest bidder with a total bid amount of \$957,028.89; and

WHEREAS, upon review of all documents submitted, Blue Pacific Engineering & Construction's bid was deemed responsive, and they are the lowest responsible bidder qualified to perform the work as described in the project specifications with an estimated completion date of Summer 2020; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding a contract to Blue Pacific Engineering & Construction in the not-to-exceed amount of \$957,028.89, authorization to establish an Engineering Grants Fund appropriation of \$889,000 and corresponding revenue budget to partially fund project construction with the remaining contract award being funded through prior City Council Capital Improvement Program (CIP) *TransNet* appropriations in the amount of \$68,028.89 for Traffic Signal Upgrades; and

WHEREAS, staff also recommends authorizing a 15% contingency in the amount of \$143,554.33 to address any unforeseen conditions that may arise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby awards the contract for the Sweetwater River Bikeway Connections/30th Street Bicycle Facilities Improvements Project to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder, to wit:




