This is a request from Church of Christ to conduct the Care for Humanity event at Kimball Park on October 23, 2022, from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. Set up for the event will commence at 4 a.m. on the day of the event.

The purpose of the event is to provide care packages, free health screenings, free school supplies and clothing. This event will consist of live music, family games and informational booths. Applicant will provide their own stage.
