RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE 2023 OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2022 the National City Police Department was approved to receive \$150,000 in grant funds from the Office of Traffic Safety; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to implement programs to reduce the number of persons killed or injured in traffic collisions and alcohol related accidents; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to fund operations such as DUI/DL checkpoints, DUI saturation patrols and other enforcement operations relating to speed and red light violations.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of National City hereby authorizes the acceptance of a grant award in the amount of \$150,000 from the Office of Traffic Safety for the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant 2023 to conduct DUI and traffic related enforcement operations.

Section 2: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Grant Agreement, attached to the Agenda Report as Attachment A.

Section 3: That the City Council authorizes the establishment of fund appropriations and corresponding revenue budget.

Section 4: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
