

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 -

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPROVE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH NATIONAL CITY ELECTRIC INCREASING THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT BY \$50,000 FOR A TOTAL AGREEMENT AMOUNT OF \$150,000.

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2020, the City of National City entered into an Agreement with National City Electric, to provide citywide specialized electrical maintenance services. The original Agreement is for a not-to-exceed amount of \$60,000, and for an initial term of three years, with the option to extend for up to three, one-year extensions; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2021, City Council adopted Resolution 2021-123 approving a First Amendment to the Agreement with National City Electric, increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$40,000 for a total agreement amount of \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, in alignment with the City's efforts to utilize local vendors and based on the performance, quality of work, and need for continuous specialized electrical maintenance services needed to assist the Engineering & Public Works Facilities Maintenance Division, staff is requesting City Council approval of a Second Amendment to the Agreement with National City Electric, increasing the not-to-exceed amount of the Agreement by \$50,000, for a total Agreement amount of \$150,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Authorizes the Mayor to execute a Second Amendment to the Agreement with National City Electric (attached to the Agenda Report as Exhibit A), increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$50,000 for a total Agreement amount of \$150,000.

Section 2: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
