**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY,
CALIFORNIA, APPOINTING BARRY SCHULTZ AS CITY ATTORNEY AND
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A THREE (3) YEAR EMPLOYMENT
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY AND BARRY SCHULTZ WITH
THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF JANUARY 1, 2023**

WHEREAS, Barry Schultz was working in the capacity of City Attorney and was selected as City Attorney for the City of National City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of National City as follows:

SECTION 1. Barry Schultz is hereby appointed to the position of City Attorney for the City of National City effective January 1, 2023.

SECTION 2. In consideration of Mr. Schultz's acceptance of the appointments made hereinabove, the City Council hereby approves the following employment terms and conditions:

A. Commencement of Employment

January 1, 2023 is hereby designated as the date of commencement of Mr. Schultz's duties to serve as City Attorney.

B. Salary / Compensation

The base salary to be paid to Mr. Schultz for his services as City Attorney, shall be \$212,256.00 annually with a 3% annual increase after year 1 and 2 upon satisfactory annual evaluations, annual payment of \$7,500 for Deferred Compensation, \$750.00 per month for vehicle allowance payable in accordance with the City's customary payroll practices.

C. Benefits

In addition to base salary, Mr. Shultz shall receive such other benefits as are provided to City Council-Appointed Officers of the City, including holidays, vacation leave, executive leave, sick leave, and insurance and retirement benefits.

SECTION 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an Employment Agreement between the City and Barry J. Schultz with an initial term of three (3) years. Said Agreement is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
