

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 -

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, 1) AWARDING A CONTRACT TO E&H GENERAL CONTRACTING INC. IN THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT \$599,810 FOR THE MLK COMMUNITY CENTER KITCHEN UPGRADES AND NEW FLOORING PROJECT CIP NO. 22-06 2) AUTHORIZING A 15% CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$89,972 FOR ANY UNFORESEEN CHANGES; AND 3) AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the MLK Community Center is in need of Kitchen Upgrades and Flooring; and

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2022, the bid solicitation was posted on PlanetBids, a free public electronic bidding system for contractors; and

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2022 and October 26, 2022, the bid solicitation was advertised in local newspapers; and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2022, two (2) bids were received by the 2:00 p.m. deadline; and

WHEREAS, upon a review of all documents submitted, E&H General Contracting Inc.'s, bid was deemed responsive and the lowest responsible bidder qualified to perform the work as described in the project specifications; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends 1) Awarding a contract to E&H General Contracting Inc. in the not-to-exceed amount \$599,810 for the base bid for the MLK Community Center Kitchen Upgrades and New Flooring Project CIP No. 22-06; 2) authorizing a 15% contingency in the amount of \$89,972 for any unforeseen changes; and 3) authorizing the Mayor to execute the contract

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the contract with E&H General Contracting Inc. for \$599,810 for the base bid for the MLK Community Center Kitchen Upgrades and New Flooring Project, CIP No. 22-06.

Section 2: Authorizes a 15% contingency in the amount of \$89,972 for any unforeseen changes.

Section 3: Authorizes accepting all bids received on November 17, 2022.

Section 4: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
