

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 -

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF SUPPORTING HEALTHY AGING THROUGH PARKS AND RECREATION (SHARP) GRANT FROM THE NATIONAL RECREATION AND PARK ASSOCIATION (NRPA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000 TO COVER COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE WALKING WITH EASE PROGRAM AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF GRANT FUND APPROPRIATIONS OF \$4,000 AND CORRESPONDING REVENUE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the National Recreation and Park Association has established the Supporting Healthy Aging in Parks Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this program is to provide funds to nonprofit and/or exempt organizations that provide opportunities for healthy aging in parks, in regions with high social vulnerability; and

WHEREAS, the City of National City applied for grant funding under the Supporting Healthy Aging in Parks Grant to fund the Walking with Ease program; and

WHEREAS, the National Recreation and Park Association agrees to grant the City of National City \$4,000 under the Supporting Healthy Aging in Parks Grant and the City of National City wishes to accept this grant; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends City Council authorize (1) acceptance of the Supporting Healthy Aging in Parks Grant from the National Recreation and Park Association in the amount of \$4,000 to cover costs associated with the Walking with Ease program and (2) the establishment of Grant Fund appropriations of \$4,000 and corresponding revenue budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Authorizes the acceptance of the Supporting Healthy Aging in Parks Grant from the National Recreation and Park Association in the amount of \$4,000 to cover costs associated with the Walking with Ease program and the establishment of Grant Fund Appropriations of \$4,000 and corresponding revenue budget.

Section 2: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
