


THE SHALL SEE THE SEE STATE OF THE SECOND SE

Proclamation





WHEREAS, preparing for, responding to, and recovering from disasters requires a strong network of community partners across San Diego jurisdictions, and that includes an important partnership with residents and businesses to ensure they are safe and prepared for emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of National City recognizes the crucial role that staff and volunteer emergency management professionals, first responders, county, cities, special districts, tribes, nonprofit and military partners contribute to helping reduce our risks and impacts of emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) plays a critical role in times of disaster by providing disaster relief and assistance, organizing trainings on disaster response skills as well as promoting disaster preparedness planning with volunteers and San Diego communities; and

WHEREAS, The CERT volunteers have supported: disaster recovery in San Diego County, people with immediate needs, supplying resources, aid, compassion, and support to those who evacuated and to those who lost their homes; and

WHEREAS, September is National Preparedness Month, and together, we must all commit to preparing our families and communities for disasters, to ensure we are safer and more resilient; therefore, the City of National City encourages all residents to be disaster prepared; and

WHEREAS, Preparedness Month serves as a reminder to ask "How prepared are you and your neighbors?" and therefore we remind residents to join National City CERT and learn what to do before, during, and after major emergencies to mitigate injuries, loss of life, and property damage; and

WHEREAS, the National City Fire Department will be providing a Spanish CERT Academy starting on Wednesday, September 13th for National City residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council commend National City CERT Members Randi Castle, Alma Verdugo, and Guadalupe Escalante for their dedication to assisting with distributing sandbags and setting up a temporary shelter for National City residents during Hurricane Hilda.
