

RESOLUTION NO. 2024 -

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE 2025 OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$195,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN APPROPRIATION AND CORRESPONDING REVENUE BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$195,000.

WHEREAS, the National City Police Department (“NCPD”) submitted an application to the Office of Traffic Safety (“OTS”) for consideration for a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (“STEP”) grant; and

WHEREAS, OTS awarded a STEP grant in the amount of \$195,000; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the STEP grant is to implement programs to reduce the number of persons killed or injured in traffic collisions and alcohol related accidents; and

WHEREAS, the STEP grant funds will be used to fund operations such as DUI/Driver’s License checkpoint, DUI saturation patrols and other enforcement operations relating to speed and red-light violations.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby authorizes the acceptance of the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program grant, grant number PT25188, from the Office of Traffic Safety in the amount of \$195,000.

Section 2: That the City Council authorizes the establishment of an appropriation of \$195,000 and a corresponding revenue budget in the Police Department Grants Fund.

Section 3: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
