

WHEREAS, in the past decade, the number of Latinas earning a college degree has grown by 103%, yet Latinas still face the largest pay gap compared to other demographic groups; and

WHEREAS, employers have the power to create lasting change by implementing fair practices and fostering inclusive workplaces, ensuring that all employees have equal opportunities to thrive; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of National City supports initiatives that call for mentorship and sponsorship programs in the workplace to help underrepresented talent, particularly Latinas, excel in their careers; and

WHEREAS, we advocate for the establishment of internships for first-generation college students, providing them with the critical experience and opportunities to enter the workforce; and

WHEREAS, we support pay equity audits as a means to ensure that all individuals are compensated fairly, regardless of gender, race or background; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of National City acknowledges that addressing the barriers faced by Latinas in the workplace ultimately benefits all employees and creates a more equitable and productive environment for everyone; and

WHEREAS, by working together we can create a community and workforce where equality, inclusion, and opportunity are not just ideals, but a lived reality for all; and
