

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA FOR ANIMAL SHELTER AND RELATED ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES FOR NATIONAL CITY IN A NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$499,656 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025.

WHEREAS, the City of Chula Vista (“Chula Vista”) owns and operates an animal care facility located at 130 Beyer Way in Chula Vista, which provides a full range of animal control services to the citizens of Chula Vista; and

WHEREAS, since 1991, the City of National City (“City”) has entered into previous agreements with Chula Vista where Chula Vista has provided animal shelter and related administrative services to City; and

WHEREAS, based on the satisfactory services previously provided to the City by Chula Vista, City desires to enter into a new one-year agreement with the City of Chula Vista for the continued provision of animal shelter services for the impounding, adoption, redemption, and care and disposition of dogs, cats, and other small animals, effective July 1, 2024 with options to extend the Agreement for four (4) additional one-year terms, for the not-to-exceed amount of \$499,656 for Fiscal Year 2025; and

WHEREAS, the pricing for each subsequent fiscal year and contract extensions shall be based on the average of animal intakes from the preceding three (3) calendar years, but the pricing cannot increase or decrease by more than 5% from the prior year.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the City of Chula Vista for animal shelter and related administrative services for the City of National City for the not-to-exceed amount of \$499,656 for Fiscal Year 2025, effective July 1, 2024 with options to extend for four (4) additional one-year terms. The Agreement is attached to the Agenda Report as Exhibit A.

Section 2: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
