SUBJECT:

Awarding a contract to Wright Construction Engineering Corp for the Granger Avenue Storm Drain Project, CIP No. 25-05.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution Entitled, "Resolution of the City of National City, California, 1) Awarding a Contract to Wright Construction Engineering Corp in the Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$272,500 for the Granger Avenue Storm Drain Project, CIP No. 25-05; 2) Authorizing a 15% Contingency in the Amount of \$40,875 for any Unforeseen Changes; and 3) Authorizing the Mayor to Execute the Contract."

BOARD/COMMISSION/COMMITTEE PRIOR ACTION:

EXPLANATION:

The project, which is located on Granger Avenue between E. 19th Street and E. 20th Street, represents the initial phase of improving the storm drainage system in this area. The primary objective of the project is to increase system capacity, as this area has been prone to flooding during high intensity rain events. Staff evaluated the system and determined that the facilities need to be upsized. The project will replace approximately 260 feet of 18-inch Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) on Granger Avenue with 24-inch RCP, in addition to other system improvements.

On May 20, 2025, a bid solicitation was posted on PlanetBids, which is a free public electronic bidding system for contractors. Additionally, the bid solicitation was advertised in local newspapers on May 24, 2025, and May 31, 2025.

On June 11, 2025, eight (8) bids were received by the 1:00 p.m. deadline and Wright Construction Engineering Corp was the apparent lowest bidder with a total bid amount of \$272,500.

Upon review of all documents submitted, Wright Construction Engineering Corp's bid was found responsive and they are the lowest responsible bidder qualified to perform the work as described in the project specifications.

Staff recommends awarding a contract to Wright Construction Engineering Corp, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$272,500 and authorizing a 15% contingency in the amount of \$40,875 to address any unforeseen conditions that may arise.
