

RESOLUTION NO. 2025 -

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, 1) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM SAN DIEGO SENIORS COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR THE “NO SENIOR ALONE” PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000 AND 2) AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CORRESPONDING APPROPRIATION AND REVENUE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, San Diego Seniors Community Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, that directly supports Senior Center programs and activities in under-resourced communities throughout San Diego County, providing resources and support for seniors at high risk of isolation; and

WHEREAS, The City of National City’s, Fifty and Better (FAB) Senior Programs provide essential services for seniors in National City such as socialization, community engagement, fitness, health and recreation programs; and

WHEREAS, FAB senior participants contributed to a community event by hand-knitting over eighty-five scarves and creating holiday-themed cards for homebound seniors, aiming to reduce isolation and foster a sense of community among older adults; and

WHEREAS, City Staff recommends acceptance of the \$2,000 grant from the San Diego Seniors Community Foundation to continue supporting FAB programming, including projects such as the hand-knitted scarves and holiday cards initiative.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NATIONAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or Designee to accept grant funds in the amount of \$2,000 from San Diego Seniors Community Foundation for the "No Senior Alone" program and authorizes the establishment of a corresponding appropriation and revenue budget in the General Fund – Community Services Department.

Section 2: That the City Clerk shall certify as to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
