SUBJECT:

Awarding a Contract to A. Vidovich Construction, Inc. for the Storm Water Pump Station Enhancements Project, CIP No. 25-11.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution Entitled, "Resolution of the City Council of the City of National City, California, 1) Awarding a Contract to A. Vidovich Construction, Inc. in the Not-To-Exceed Amount of \$184,980 for the Storm Water Pump Station Enhancements Project, CIP No. 25-11; 2) Authorizing a 15% Contingency in the Amount of \$27,747 for any Unforeseen Changes; and 3) Authorizing the Mayor to Execute the Contract."

BOARD/COMMISSION/COMMITTEE PRIOR ACTION:

EXPLANATION:

The Storm Water Pump Station Enhancements Project, CIP No. 25-11, will provide a new SDG&E service to the existing City pump station. The project will be installing a new concrete pad, meter and disconnect switch; intercepting and extending the pump building feeder; and coordinating with SDG&E to re-establish a new 120/240, 3 phase, 4 wire service. The project also includes removal and replacement of the existing storm water pump automatic control system with a new pump control system, reconnecting all existing power and control conductors, and commissioning the new pump control system.

On September 16, 2025, the bid solicitation was posted on PlanetBids, a free public electronic bidding system for contractors. On September 19 and 30, 2025, the bid solicitation was advertised in the local newspaper. On October 9, 2025, three (3) bids were received by the 1:00 p.m. deadline (see Exhibit A – Bid Opening Summary).

A. Vidovich Construction, Inc. was the apparent lowest bidder with a total bid amount of \$184,980. Upon review of all documents submitted, A. Vidovich Construction, Inc.'s bid was deemed responsive and they are the lowest responsible bidder qualified to perform the work as described in the project specifications.

Staff recommends awarding a contract to A. Vidovich Construction, Inc. in the not to-exceed amount of \$184,980 and authorizing a 15% contingency in the amount of \$27,747 to address any unforeseen conditions that may arise.
