**ITEM TITLE:** **REQUEST FOR THE INSTALLATION OF RED CURB “NO PARKING” AT TWO STORM DRAIN INLETS AT THE INTERSECTION OF E. 22ND AND B AVENUE TO PREVENT VEHICLES FROM BLOCKING ACCESS TO THE STORM DRAIN INLETS.**

**DISCUSSION:**

Residents in the area have requested that the staff assess the runoff conditions between 18th Street, 22nd Street, National City Blvd, and D Avenue. This evaluation is needed to reduce flooding risks for vehicles and properties located near the low point during heavy storm events. Additionally, residents have asked for the installation of red curb markings to indicate no parking in the vicinity of existing curb openings. This measure will help prevent parked vehicles from obstructing the inlets and grates, which could limit their ability to efficiently convey water to the storm drain system.

Staff conducted a site evaluation of the intersection at E. 22nd and B Avenue and determined that there red curbs “No Parking” installed by the storm drain inlets. The storm drain system is an important component of the city’s stormwater management system, as it allows runoff to enter the underground drainage network, preventing localized flooding and water accumulation on streets. When vehicles are parked directly in front of or over a storm drain inlet, it can cause significant operational issues. For this reason, staff recommends the installation of red curbs "No Parking" as a measure to enhance the performance of the stormwater system. Additionally, staff is working on further enhancements to address flooding concerns from the area residents.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on evaluation of existing conditions, staff recommends the following enhancements:

- Install 40 feet of red curb “No Parking” on the north side of E. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, west of B Avenue. This will result in the loss of one (2) on-street parking space;
- Install 20 feet of red curb “No Parking” on the south side of E. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. This will result in the loss of one (1) on-street parking space;
- Install 20 feet of red curb “No Parking” on the west side of B Avenue, north of E. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street to comply with daylighting laws. This will result in the loss of one (1) on-street parking space.

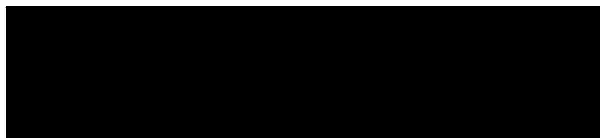
Dear Sir/Madame:

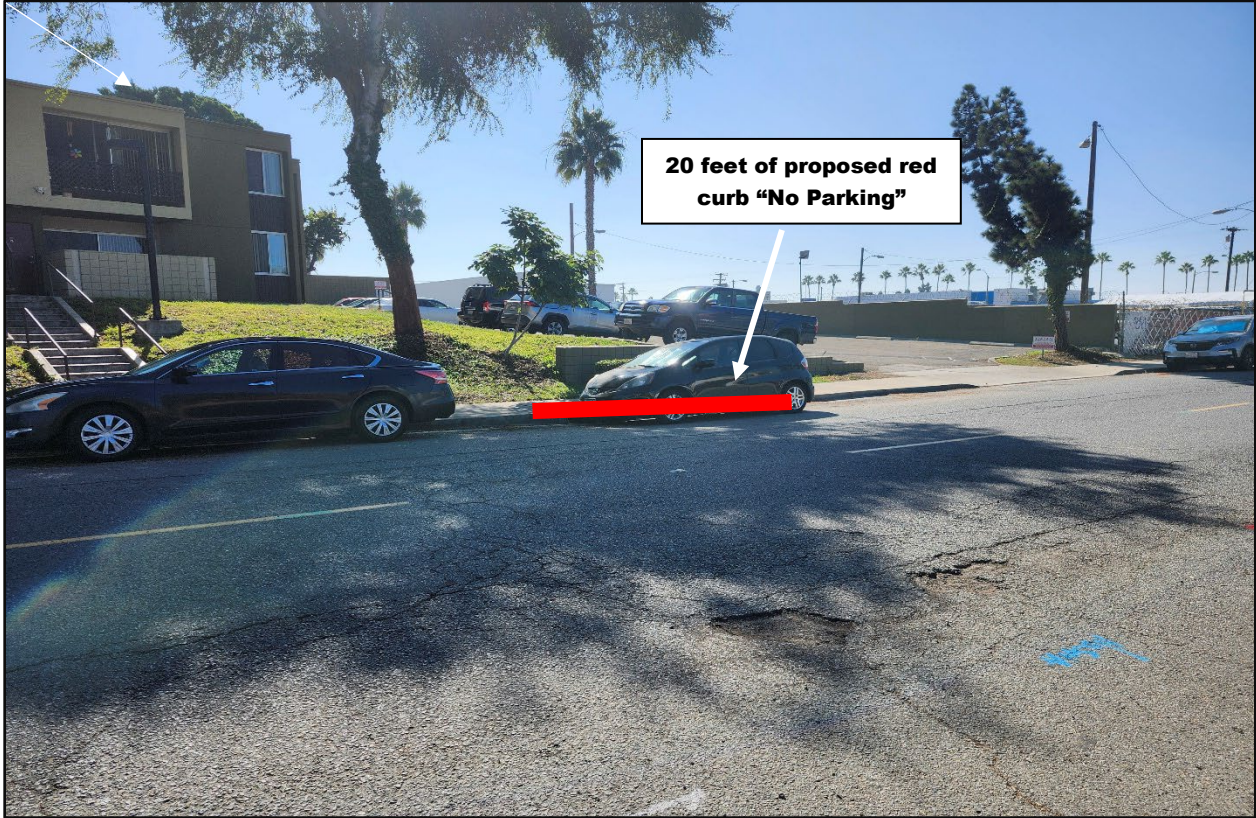

# Location Map with Recommended Enhancements (TSC Item: 2025-20)

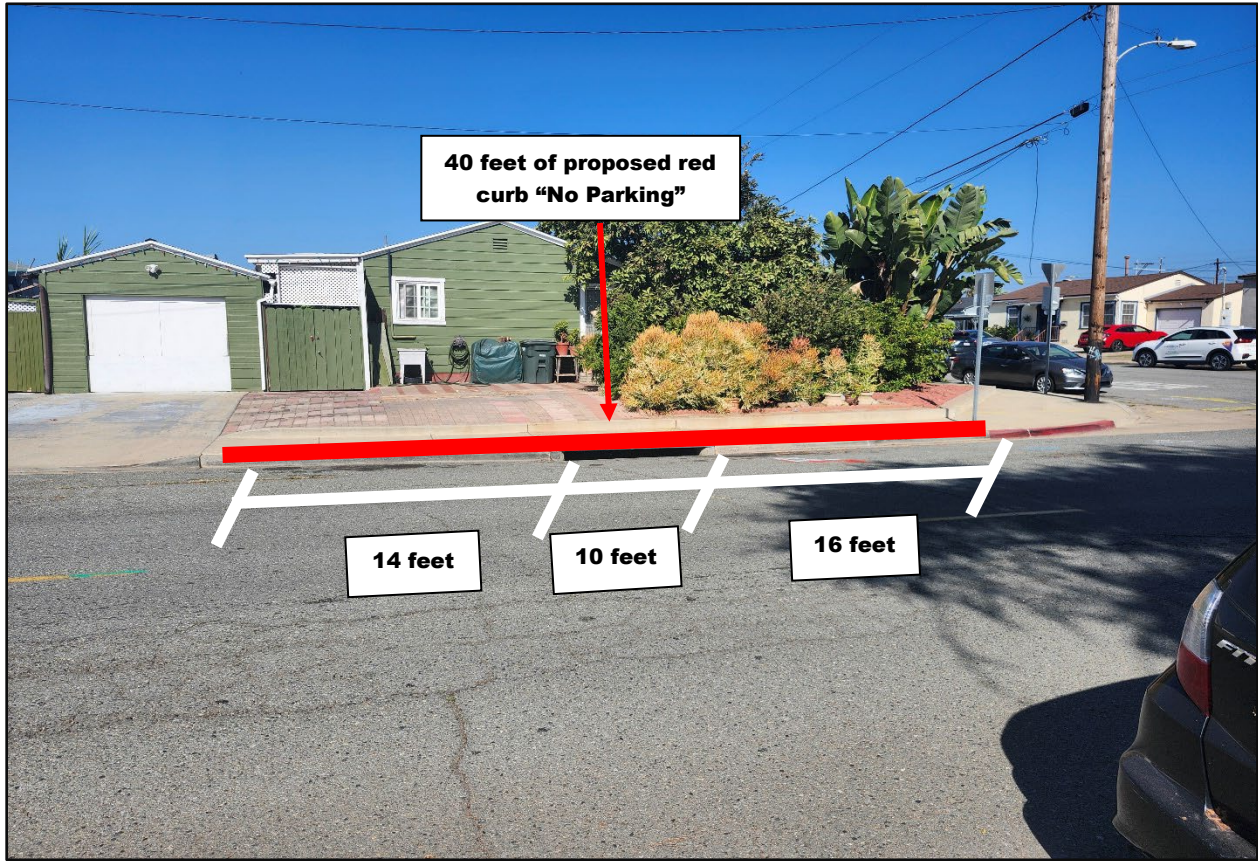




Install Stop red curb "No Parking" on the south side of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street (looking south)
